PROCEEDS FROM PAINTINGS TO BENEFIT WOUNDED SOLDIERS

Massachusetts Artist Steven Leahy will donate the proceeds from five military themed miniature paintings to the US Wounded Soldiers Foundation.



Stoughton, MA - November 29, 2010 - Artist Steven Leahy will display five paintings done on standard size military dog tags as part of his first solo show 'Small Efforts' to be held at the SAART Gallery (www.saartgallery.com) in Stoughton, Massachusetts on January 16th, 2011. Each branch of the military is represented in these tiny, 1 inch by 2 inch paintings and 100% of the proceeds from these five paintings will be donated to the US Wounded Soldiers Foundation to help benefit soldiers that are injured during service overseas.

The US Wounded soldiers Fund (www.uswoundedsoldiers.com) was started in 2003 by Teresa Goforth. The mission of the foundation is to provide for the needs of our combat veterans deployed in Iraq and Afghanistan. "We have taken our heroes under our wings for the sacrifice they have made fighting for our freedom."
